SUBJECT: Changes to Time Warner Cable PEG Stations

The City of Greensboro was recently notified of changes to Time Warner Cable's delivery of its Public, Education and Government (PEG) channels, including Greensboro Television Network (GTN). Starting October 8, 2013, Time Warner Cable is transition all PEG channels to digital format.

In digital format, GTN will still be available on Channel 13 as part of Time Warner Cable's "Basic Service Tier" lineup. However, residents will need digital cable, or a digital adapter, to view GTN along with Channel 8/Public Access TV and Channel 2/Guilford County Schools TV.

Between now and December 8, 2013, residents who do not have digital cable can request digital adapters from Time Warner. The digital adapters will be offered at no cost through January 1, 2015, at which time the cable provider will charge 99 cents per month.

We received a total of 5 comments this week:

Field Operations – 4 comments:

- On August 22, 2013, I emailed the Greensboro City Council asking who was responsible for maintaining a portion of the horrible surface on heavily traveled Aycock Street between High Point Road and Florida Street. The next day, August 23, 2013, I received an email from The City of Greensboro's Contact Center stating my message had been received and a work order had been entered for their Field Operations Department and that someone would investigate as soon as possible. Today, September 21, 2013, I traveled Aycock Street between High Point Road and Florida Street and the surface is smooth as glass! I don't know when it was resurfaced or who on council received and forwarded this item. I don't know if the job was already scheduled for resurfacing. I don't know who represents that section of Greensboro, could be T. Dianne Bellamy-Small, but I do see the city at work using tax dollars to maintain the infrastructure. Thank you.
- Customer is very happy with the Mattress Go Round service.
- Caller is handicapped and couldn't handle the cans. For seven years, her wonderful neighbors took care of getting her
 cans to the curbside. When they moved, she didn't know what to do, so she called the City. The supervisor that
 worked with her to make other arrangements was so wonderful and so helpful. She didn't know what she was going to
 do after her kind neighbors left but she was so thankful that the City stepped up to accommodate her unique needs.
- I would just like for you to know that it is quite inefficient and unsustainable for the closest place to recycle Styrofoam
 to be in Randleman, North Carolina. Why isn't there one in every city? I am willing to go the extra mile and recycle
 everything I can, but, it is asking too much of North Carolinians to drive to another city, especially one over an hour
 away to recycle their Styrofoam. We need to recycle everything possible. I would like for this message to reach
 someone who takes recycling and environmentalism seriously.

Water Resources - 1 comment:

• Thanks the Contact Center rep who insisted he had a leak. Turns out, the rep was right and despite his reluctance to accept it, the customer found a leak that was causing his bill to be higher than normal. If the rep hadn't been so insistent, he may have allowed this leak to continue which would have been very expensive.
