

Procedures For Application of Capacity Use Fee(s) Effective Date 01/01/1999

BUILDING STATUS All buildings existing prior to 07/01/1989 (located inside or outside city limits).

ACTION Exempt regardless of connection date.

BUILDING STATUS All buildings with building permits issued prior to 07/01/1989 (located inside or outside city limits).

ACTION Exempt regardless of connection date.

BUILDING STATUS Any single-family, not for rent, detached residential unit containing 1200 square feet, or less, and any such attached unit containing 1000 square feet, or less (includes detached houses, patio homes, manufactured/mobile homes, condominiums,

ACTION Exempt from the capacity use fee if located inside city limits. All residential units outside the city limits are subject to capacity use fee (CUF) based on heated square footage.

BUILDING STATUS Any single-family, not for rent, detached residential dwelling not covered above (includes detached houses, patio homes, manufactured/mobile homes). **Detached** (1201 to 1822 sq. ft) or **Attached** (1001 to 1822 sq. ft).

Residential Inside: Water = .5379 cents x sq. ft Sewer = \$1.08 cents x sq. ft

Residential Outside: Water = .5434 cents x sq. ft Sewer = \$1.09 cents x sq. ft

Over 1822 sq. ft see current rate for water and sewer inside/outside (CUF chart – commercial properties).

When a meter size is increased on an existing building due to a renovation or change of use, and the building was built prior to 07/01/1989, the <u>CUF IS EXEMPT</u>.

If a new building or addition to the existing building is served, CUF will be due based on the <u>larger meter or</u> <u>additional meter size</u> (refer to rates on CUF chart). (2003)
