DOWNTOWN WEEKEND TROLLEY PILOT PROGRAM

\$18,000

Project Description:

The service will be provided by a contracted private business and will operate on Saturday nights from 6 pm to midnight from March through November. Funding is for one (1) year only as a pilot program.

CTE YOUTH TRAINING PROGRAMING SUPPLEMENTATION
