\$50,000

DOWNTOWN WEEKEND TROLLEY PILOT PROGRAM

\$18,000

Project Description:

This project is a pilot program that would provide a trolley service to access downtown businesses, parks, and entertainment with connections to sites such as NC A&T University, UNCG, and First National Bank Field. The service will be provided by a contracted private business and will operate on Saturday nights from 6 pm to midnight from March through November. Funding is for one (1) year only as a pilot program.
