Majority of revenue received by the City is sent directly from the State and is based on sales tax imposed on cable, satellite, hotel/motel video sales and telecom as described through the 2006 Video Competition Act. The state tax replaces some of the franchise fees now being charged local cable franchise operators. The 101-6010-01.7215 account will continue to receive installments from Time Warner pertaining to installation, equipment, home shopping, and advertising for a limited amount of time and the state received funds are placed into the following accounts:

Kimberly,

The largest item is that City Council changed the rates that franchisees are charged from \$3.00 per linear foot to \$1.75 per linear foot. Secondly, we negotiated a settlement through City Legal with Qwest (a franchisee) and AT&T assumed a franchisee that was in bankruptcy. These three items led to the variance in revenue from FY 2007 to FY 2008.
