- This \$378.00 was collected for the event Carolina Karting Merchandise and was deposited in the wrong account, it should have been deposited into 521-7535-08-7741
 - 2 This \$6,192.48 is our facility concessions revenue and will always fluctuate based on our actual events, which varies year to year.
 - 3 This \$15,131.26 is our facility catering revenue and will always fluctuate based on our actual events, which varies year to year.
- 4 This \$8,500 is event related sponsorship and vary depending on which event is assigned this co-promoted event account from year to year.
 - 5 Facility Sponsorship revenue varies depending on current and expiring revenue contracts
- 6 This \$2,500 for advertising display should have been deposited in the main advertising display account 521-7535-08-7773
- 7 This \$915 variance is event related advertising and vary depending on which event is assigned this co-promoted event account from year to year.
 - 8 Facility Advertising revenue varies depending on current and expiring revenue contracts
- 9 This \$60 for telephone fees should have been deposited in the main advertising display account 521-7535-08-7775
- 10 This \$586 variance is event related advertising and vary depending on which event is assigned this co-promoted event account from year to year.
 - 11 Telephone fees account fluctuate on actual number of shows that use services
- 12 This \$37,000 was a one time fee collected for rent related to space reserved for Hurricane Katrina victims.
 - 13 Partial collection of Box Office service fees, mainly collected now in 521-7510-02-7746.
- 14 This \$35 variance is event related advertising and vary depending on which event is assigned this co-promoted event account from year to year.
 - 15 These are service charges for decorators and audio visual mainly, will fluctuate with event activity.

Kimberly-

The Coliseum has received your memo dated 11/18/08 inquiring about the factors that determine which events come to the Greensboro Coliseum and what influence the City has over those factors.

Deputy Director Scott Johnson and Booking & Marketing Director Carrie Paglinco are responsible for booking events for the Coliseum Complex. Our facility has a policy to book as many events as possible in order to generate as much revenue as possible as well as provide a wide variety of cultural opportunities for the citizens of Greensboro. The more events we host, the greater number of patrons in attendance. This, in turn, leads to additional opportunities to increase several critical revenue streams including concessions, parking and merchandise sales (all of which are all based on attendance).

Another critical factor in booking is our outstanding relationship with several of the largest concert promoters in the nation. These long standing and mutually beneficial relationships, have allowed us to compete with the bigger cities and newer facilities in the Southeast.

Since his hiring in 1994, the City has given Managing Director Matt Brown the authority to be the final decision on the booking of events for our Complex.
