The Internal Audit Division has conducted an audit of the Glenwood Recreation Center, which is supervised by the Greensboro Parks and Recreation Department. The Center offers a wide variety of programs for youths and adults including Summer Day Camp, Taekwondo, Kickboxing, Introductory Fencing, and Dixic Derbies Square Dance. They also host several community organizations' meetings such as the Chinese Association, Delta H. Fencers Club, Glenwood Neighborhood Association, the A.A.R.P. Board, and the Glenwood Focus Group.

The objectives of this audit are to determine whether:

- Effective oversight is being provided over the revenue collection process, including adequate internal controls in the cash handling process exist to ensure that cash receipts are accurately recorded and deposited in a timely manner.
- Cash disbursements are properly approved and supported with documentation.
- Effective oversight over the payroll process exists.
- Equipment and property recorded exist and are adequately safeguarded.

Per our audit, it appears that Glenwood Recreation Center operates in accordance with policies and procedures set forth by the Parks and Recreation Department. We commend the Center Supervisor for her conscientious effort in ensuring that all cash receipts are accounted for and deposited in a timely manner by recording the deposit date on each receipt, and making frequent deposits. This was an area of concern in a previous audit of the Center, which has since been corrected.
