The Internal Audit Division has performed a program and compliance audit of the Presbyterian Church of the Cross, which received a Human Services Grant in the amount of \$12,000 from the City of Greensboro during the 2002-2003 grant year.

The PCC grant is designed to help support the administrative and operational expenditures incurred with their Community Nursing Program to provide basic nursing care for low-to moderate-income elderly people and their families. This program offers health screenings; health education; inoculations and referrals for immigrants who would not otherwise receive them. During the grant year, the nurse providing these services had to reduce the amount of time allotted to this program and therefore the grant was reduced from \$12,000 to \$3,000. Over 400 clients were served during the grant year.

We examined selected financial transactions and program documentation maintained by the agency for compliance with the contract and for the assurance that program goals were achieved. Based on our review, it appears that the funds have been spent according to the terms of the contract with no exceptions noted.
