The Internal Audit Division has performed a program and compliance audit of Claremont Educational Program, Incorporated which received a Human Services Grant from the City of Greensboro in the amount of \$14,800 during the 2001-2002 grant year. This grant was reduced to \$11,100 due to the City's budget constraints.

The CEP grant helped support the administrative and operational expenses incurred with their summer and after school programs for children in grades K-5 in the Claremont neighborhoods. These children are helped with homework; attend computer classes; helped with reading and writing skills; and get to interact with other children. Approximately 37 children were served during the grant year.

We examined selected financial transactions and program documentation maintained by the agency for compliance with the contract and for assurance that program goals were achieved. Based on our review, it appears that the funds have been spent according to the terms of the contract with no exceptions noted.
