The Internal Audit Division has performed a program and compliance audit of the Gate City Community Development Corporation, which received a Human Services Grant in the amount of \$17,275 from the City of Greensboro during the 2001-2002 grant year. Only \$12,956.25 was dispersed to this agency because of budget constraints.

This GCCDC grant helps support the administrative and operational expenditures incurred with the Certified Nursing Assistant training program designed to help train individuals in southeast Greensboro. This program offers an eight-week program at organizations such as Guilford Technical Community College and JobLink for persons to obtain training for job placement. Approximately 32 individuals successfully completed the program during the grant year.

We examined selected financial transactions and program documentation maintained by the agency for compliance with the contract and for assurance that program goals were achieved. Based on our review it appears that the funds have been spent according to the terms of the contract with no exceptions noted.
