## AMENDING CHAPTER 30 (LDO) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GREENSBORO CODE OF ORDINANCES WITH RESPECT TO ZONING, PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

Section 1. That Subsection (D) of Section 30-14-9.8, Electronic and Digital Display, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(D) When located within 300 feet of a residential district building containing a principal residential use in a residential zoning district, the replacement sign must be turned off between midnight and 7 a.m. and a Special use Permit is required before replacement and conversion. In addition, the conversion to an electronic display in the –DDO, Downtown Design Overlay is allowed only if approved as a Special use Permit. Electronic displays are prohibited in the –DDO Historic Core.

Section 2. All ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon date of adoption.
