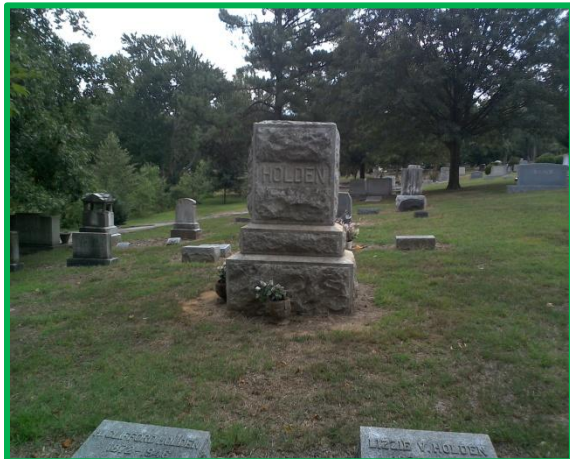


Green Hill Cemetery Walking Tours

The Friends of Green Hill Cemetery, a volunteer-lead organization, provide historic walking tours of the cemetery throughout the year. These tours raise funds for the enhancement of the plantings and structures within the cemetery and are meant to increase the visitor's knowledge of Greensboro's history and of the local and unusual plants thriving within Green Hills' 51 acres.

Funds from the tours are also used to purchase benches for visitors, and recently, to create a mid-cemetery "gathering area" with picnic tables under one of Green Hill's magnificent old oak trees.

Green Hill is also host to many names associated with our city streets, schools, and other prominent burials.



Cemetery walking tours are \$5 per person.
