Boating Rules:

- All boats must be off the water 30 minutes prior to closing time
- All sales end one hour and thirty minutes prior to closing time
- Boats must enter and exit the lake from the marina only
- Children under 13 must wear a PFD while on the water
- The minimum age for boat rental or private boat launch is 16
- Ages 9-15 may be in a boat by themselves with a parent/quardian and a signed waiver
- Ages 8 and under must be in a boat with an adult
- A child must be of walking age to be allowed in any rental boat
- Animals are not permitted in any rental boats
- Fishing is not allowed on rental kayaks, canoes, or paddleboards
- PFDs must be worn by everyone on rental kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards
- Private motors smaller than 10hp are allowed on rental rowboats
- Rental boats and equipment must be returned to original location
- · Rental boat maximum capacities:

Sailboats: Aquafins: 2 people, Lazer Pico: 2 people, Capri: 3 people Rowboats: 3 people (Exception: One 4-person boat is available at each lake)

Solo kayak: 1 person, Tandem kayak: 2 people, Canoe: 2 people

Paddleboard: 1 person

The following are NOT PERMITTED:

- Swimming and/or wading
- Alcohol or open fires
- Bank fishing and dead line fishing
- . Skiing, jet skiing, or wind surfing
- · Drones and radio-controlled watercraft
- No boats within 150 feet of pier and boathouse
- Fishing, boating, or sailing in restricted areas
- · Unsafe watercraft as determined by the Lake staff
- Inflatable watercraft not intended to be paddled or motorized - no pool floats

Greensboro City Lakes Annual Passes

3-Lake Annual Pass \$120 Seniors and Veterans \$100

Private power boat launch, sailboat launch, rental rowboat, and pier fishing at all 3 Lakes.

1-Lake Annual Pass \$60 Seniors and Veterans \$50

Private power boat launch, sailboat launch, rental rowboat, and pier fishing at 1 Lake.

Solo Paddle Pass \$60 Seniors and Veterans \$50

Launch of 1 canoe, kayak, or paddleboard at all 3 Lakes.

Group Paddle Pass \$120 Seniors and Veterans \$100

Launch of up to 3 canoes, kayaks, or paddleboards at all 3 Lakes.

Pier Fishing Pass \$40

Pier fishing for one person at all 3 City Lakes.
