

Residential Referenced Plan Program

PROCEDURE:

The intent of this program is to allow residential building plans that have been previously reviewed *under the current code cycle* to be repetitively reused *by the same Contractor* without further plan review by the Inspections Department. This previously stamped approved plan is to be made available to the building inspector for all field inspections. A certified stamped copy of our file set, *if still available*, may be provided at a cost.
