Operation Identification Program

This program deters burglars, assists in arrests and prosecution of criminals as well as facilitates the return of stolen property. An engraver is available from your Community Resource Officer. Block captains can borrow the engraver and let the neighborhood take turns engraving their property.

- Mark valuables by inscribing your driver's license followed by your state's letters.
- Create a property list of items you have engraved, including the make, model, size, color, serial number, date of purchase and amount. You can use [this form](#) to keep record.

Home Security Survey Program

Crime prevention begins at home through improved home security. Your Community Resource Officer will conduct a home security survey upon request. The survey will identify problem areas and will provide guidance for their correction. Encourage other residents to improve the security of their homes by identifying points of vulnerability.
