GCJAC's purpose is to:

ADVISE

Work throughout the justice system, including GPD and the courts

Communicate through regular reports and interact with the public

The Police Community Review Board (PCRB) is a subcommittee of the GCJAC. The PCRB is an advisory Board, consisting of several members of the Greensboro community. This Board is responsible for reviewing, assessing, and reporting on administrative investigations and findings of the Greensboro Police Department's Professional Standards Division (PSD) concerning allegations of misconduct against sworn members of the Greensboro Police Department.



Filing a Complaint

Not Satisfied with PSD's Decision?

If you are unsatisfied with the decision of the PSD, you may appeal that decision to the PCRB for review. The appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date the PSD Determination Letter was mailed to you. The PCRB will then review all relevant information, including, but not limited to, PSD's investigative file, body-worn camera recordings, and any other information you deem relevant. For timely appeals filed with the PCRB, the matter will be reviewed by the Board within 60 days of receiving the final draft of your appeal.
