

FY 2020-2029 MTIP Amendment: Add New Projects HS 2007, RC-2007 & RX-2007

- Establishes NCDOT umbrella projects for future use
 - HS-2007: safety improvements at high need locations
 - RC-2007 rail / traffic separation study implementation
 - RX-2007 at-grade rail crossing safety improvements
- Funds will be added and schedules set at a later time
- Will facilitate preliminary work & save time later on

MTIP Amendment: EB-5883 Wendover Avenue Sidewalks



2.4 miles of STI funded sidewalk construction, repair, & roadway modifications

- Shifts r/w to FY 2021 and construction to FY 2022
- Increases funds for r/w to \$450,000, construction \$2.7 million






Amendment needed for consistency with MTIP amendments

MPO Project Ranking Methodology

•Step Four: Assignment of Local Points

- Quantitative/ Qualitative Assessment
- ► 1800 points (Regional and Division Tiers)
- >Up to 100 points per project
- >Assigning Points across All Modes
- ▶ Points Can be Donated

Prioritization Process Update

MPO Project Ranking Methodology

•Step Four: Assignment of Local Points (cont.)

➤ Quantitative/ Qualitative Assessment

Based on 6 Factors:

١.	Relative performance in NCDOT's quantitative scoring process	40%
2.	Support Multi-modalism (bicycle, pedestrian, transit, or freight)	10%
3.	Identified on the MPO Priority List	15%
4.	Feasibility of obtaining funding and construction of project during fiscal years 2020-2029	15%
5.	Impact to local budget	10%
6.	Impact to economic development	10%

- TAC Chair has provided letter of endorsement


