

2016 Bond Goals

Improve Streets



Transportation bonds approved to buy, build, extend, widen, repave and improve streets, sidewalks and other transportation infrastructure.



\$18M TO PAVE STREETS



\$5M FOR BUSES AND TRANSIT INFRASTRUCTURE



\$5M TO MATCH FEDERAL FUNDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS

Accomplished to date:

- Paved 152 lane miles of streets.
- Purchased 10 bus shelters.
- Replaced 1,100 bus stop signs.
- Leveraged \$14 million state and federal dollars to buy 23 buses, an electric bus charger, and 45 paratransit vans.
- Renovated the Depot.
- Leveraged \$20 million in federal transportation funds to improve East Gate City Boulevard, provided pedestrian improvements at 30 intersections and constructed 6.7 miles of sidewalk.



Improve Downtown Streetscapes



Transportation bonds approved to buy, build, improve or otherwise equip urban renewal and community development projects.



\$25M FOR DOWNTOWN STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Accomplished to date:

- \$5.1 million spent, \$7.1 million obligated.
- Downtown Streetscape Master Plan.
- Eugene-Bellemeade, Davie, Greene and Summit streetscapes designed. Construction slated to begin in the next year.
- Designs underway for Elm streetscape.
