### MTIP Amendment & Modification: Roadway & Rail


• I-5955: rehabilitate pavement on I-40 from Holden to east of Gate City. Shifts construction from FY 2022 to FY 2023 and increases construction funding by \$1.2 million.

• P-5713: convert atgrade crossing to grade separation on Hilltop Road at the NCRR. Shifts right of way from FY 23 to FY 24 & construction from FY 25 to FY 26.

Total funding reduced \$1.6 million to \$13.3 million.



### MTIP Modification: Stand-alone Sidewalk Projects



### Fleming-Lewiston Connector & Interchange Amendment

### History

- Project conceived in 1996 to increase connectivity & loop access
- Submitted in NCDOT prioritization P2 P5: scored poorly
- Not resubmitted in P6 for that reason
- Request to remove project to facilitate nearby land development

#### **Evaluation Process**

- High level staff analysis of the pros and cons
- Feasiblity Study prepared by Davenport
- 30-day Public Review Period
- consultation with NCDOT, Town of Summerfield, and Guilford County
- TCC input / consultation with member agencies


### Public Involvement

- Public comment period from 7/7 to 8/5
- 20 of 21 survey responses supported connector & interchange
  - current & future traffic congestion
  - improved connectivity
  - convenient access to the loop
  - continuing area development
  - Enhanced access between Summerfield & Greensboro
- Email comment from BIG advocacy committee stated the connector would provide a needed link for bicyclists
- Opportunity to speak provided at today's meeting


### Consultation with TCC Agencies

- Summerfield noted connector roadway appears needed but interchange does not
- Guilford County Planning concurred with that assessment
- NCDOT Division 7 reported current FHWA minimum interchange spacing rules would not allow the interchange



### Cost-effectiveness & Funding Outlook

- Staff did not prepare a comprehensive cost effectiveness analysis
- Lack of information limited assessment of competitiveness in NCDOT prioritization process to a cursory review
- Based on estimated cost and area congestion, connector not likely to be highly competitive
- Longer range competitiveness for the connector appears to depend on likely cost consistent with estimate & actual future traffic exceeding levels estimated in staff and Davenport analysis
- Operational and intersection improvements on existing roadways could be more competitive and cost effective in the mid-term
- Selecting cost-effective strategies is crucial given limited budgets for transportation improvements and a plethora of needs

### High Level Considerations

- Analysis indicates limited traffic flow benefit from the connector
- New route for bicycles and pedestrians not included in analysis, but would be a project benefit
- Operational & bicycle/pedestrian improvements on existing area roadways more cost effective in mid to long term
- Competitiveness of the connector project for future funding appears questionable
- Transcontinental pipeline, jurisdictional stream and wetland on site complicate constructability
- Impacts on efficient development of land & land use & economic development goals

### Staff Recommendation

- Remove Fleming-Lewiston Connector Interchange at I-840 from area transportation plans
- Remove the Fleming-Lewiston Connector from area transportation plans
- Reclassify Lewiston Road and Fleming Road north of Bryan Boulevard from major thoroughfare to minor thoroughfare



### STIP Schedule & Next Steps

- NCDOT Divisions will hold public drop-in sessions this fall. The specific dates are to be determined but are anticipated in the September/October timeframe.
- All swaps will now be due by Friday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023, EXCEPT for projects in the Gastonia-Cleveland-Lincoln MPO, Charlotte Regional Transportation Planning Organization, and Cabarrus-Rowan MPO. In order to meet the air quality conformity analysis schedule, project swaps in these three MPOs must be finalized by October 28, 2022.
