


MTIP Amendment & Modification: Statewide Projects

National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Program



Established by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, the <u>National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure</u>, or <u>NEVI, Program</u> provides nearly \$5 billion from July 2022-June 2027 to help states create a network of 500,000 electric vehicle charging stations along designated alternative fuel corridors. North Carolina expects to receive up to \$109 million to build out EV infrastructure along its approved corridors.

Recent and Pending Bid Openings

Downtown Greenway, Phase 4 - Contract 2015-0030

Plan revisions to incorporate value engineering ideas are underway

Changes inlcude removal of enhancement area along Greensboro's College's campus

& elimination of the extension of the A&Y Greenway from Smith St. to Benjamin Parkway.

Plan to put out to bid in January to have a construction start of May 2023

Greene Street Streetscape - Contract 2018-0480

Waterline installation is expected to begin in January 2023

The completion date for the contract is 450 days from NTP

Projects limits are from Washington St. to Bellemeade St.

Alamance Church Road Improvements - Contract 2011-0670

Clearing and private utility relocations are complete

New waterline and storm sewer installation is ongoing

Widening is being installed in areas where utility installations are complete

Construction is expected to be completed by spring 2024

Ballinger Road Bridge Replacement - Contract 2016-037A

Bridge work is currently underway

Utility instatllations are complete with widening work underway

Expected to be open by December 15, 2022

Eugene & Bellemeade Streetscape - Contract 2020-0180

Waterline has been installed on Bellemeade St. from Edgeworth St. to Eugene St.

Waterline installation has begun on Eugene, to be complete by December 15

Utility installations on Bellemeade Street East to follow

Streetscape work to begin on Eugene in early 2023 and continue onto Bellemeade

Summit Avenue Streetscape - Contract 2018-0200

Milling and utilty adjustment is currently taking place

Streetscape work is ongoing, with plans to finish Yanceyville this year

Phase 1 is expected to be completed by Spring 2023

Phase 2 utility work to begin in January 2023 due to Tanger holiday events

Phase 2 streetscape work will begin upon completion of phase 1

Both Sides from Cone Blvd. to Cornwalis Drive

Construction is complete with the exception of final crosswalk markings


