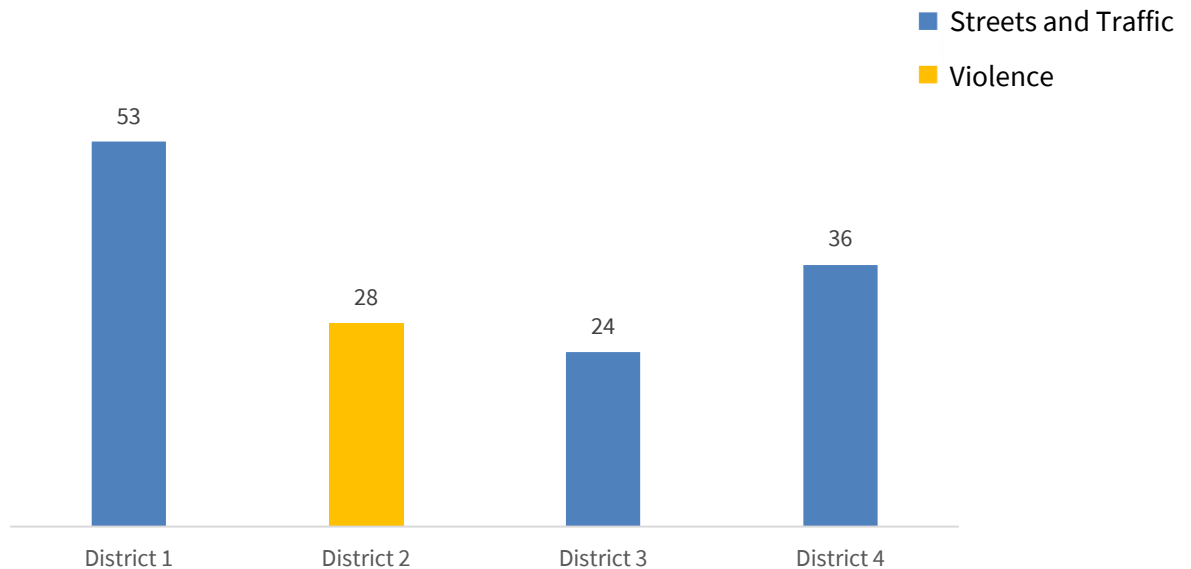


**Q4 2022 Blockwise Report : Streets and Traffic are primary concerns for all districts except district 2; District 2’s primary concern is Violence and scores the lowest on the sense of safety and trust metrics**

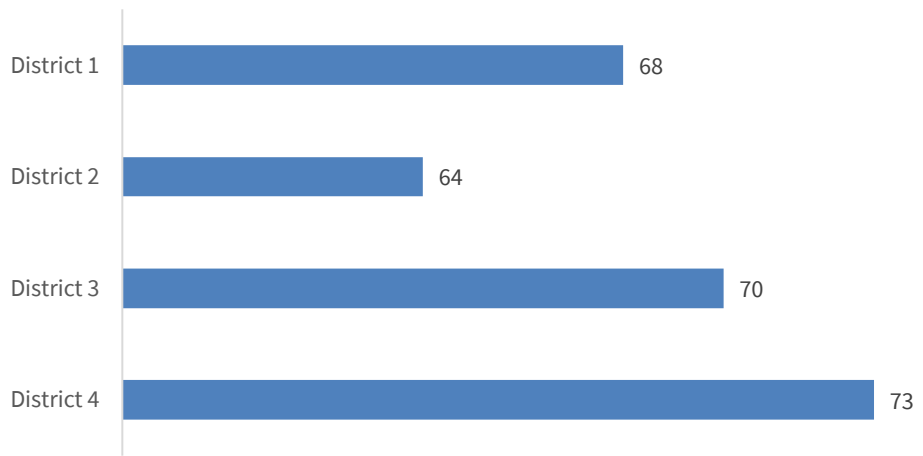
Top Concern by districts



Between October 1– December 31, 2022 (Q4), the Greensboro Police Department received 511\* responses to the question, “**What is the number-one problem on your block or neighborhood that you would like the police to deal with?**”

- District 1’s leading response was Streets and Traffic, with 53 responses comprising over a third (37%) of all responses for that district.
- District 2’s leading response was Violence, with 28 responses comprising over a fourth (29%) of all responses for that district.
- District 3’s leading response was Streets and Traffic, with 24 responses comprising a fourth (25%) of all responses for that district.
- District 4’s leading response was Streets and Traffic, with 36 responses comprising almost half (43%) of all responses for that district.

### Sense of Safety



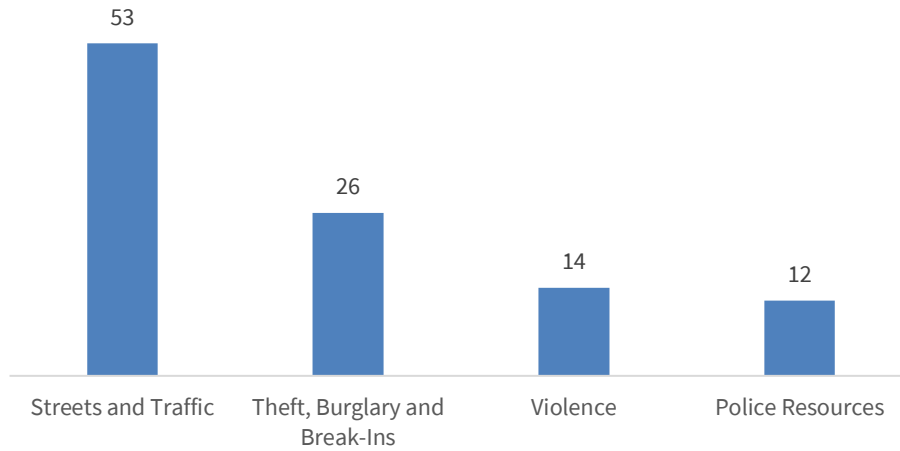
District 4 scored highest on the sense of safety, and district 2 scored the lowest. The overall citywide score was 69 in Q4.

### Level of Trust



District 4 scored highest on the Level of Trust, and district 2 scored the lowest. The overall citywide score was 69 in Q4.

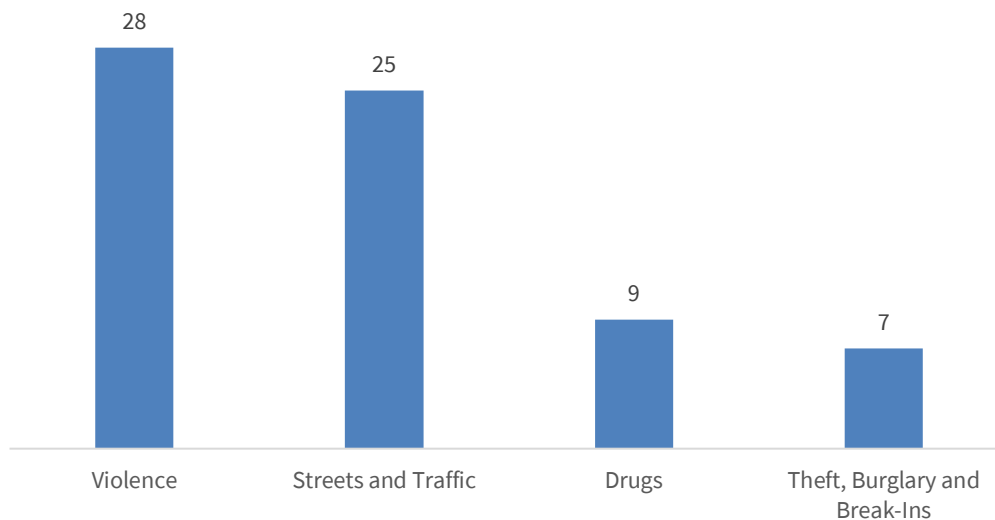
### Top Concerns - District 1



**District 1 leading concerns were distributed as follows:**

- 37% of respondents (53 responses) mentioned Streets and Traffic as their top concern.
- 18% of respondents (26 responses) mentioned Theft, Burglary, and Break-Ins.
- 10% of respondents (14 responses) mentioned Violence.
- 8% of respondents (12 responses) mentioned Police Resources.

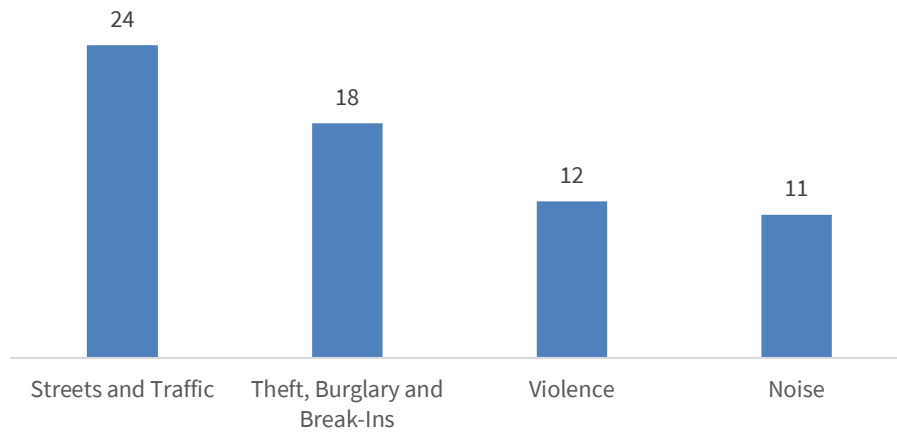
### Top Concerns - District 2



**District 2 leading concerns were distributed as follows:**

- 29% of respondents (28 responses) mentioned Violence as their top concern.
- 26% of respondents (25 responses) mentioned Streets and Traffic.
- 9% of respondents (9 responses) mentioned Drugs.
- 7% of respondents (7 responses) mentioned Theft, Burglary, and Break-Ins.
- Additional 7 responses (7%) mentioned Noise.

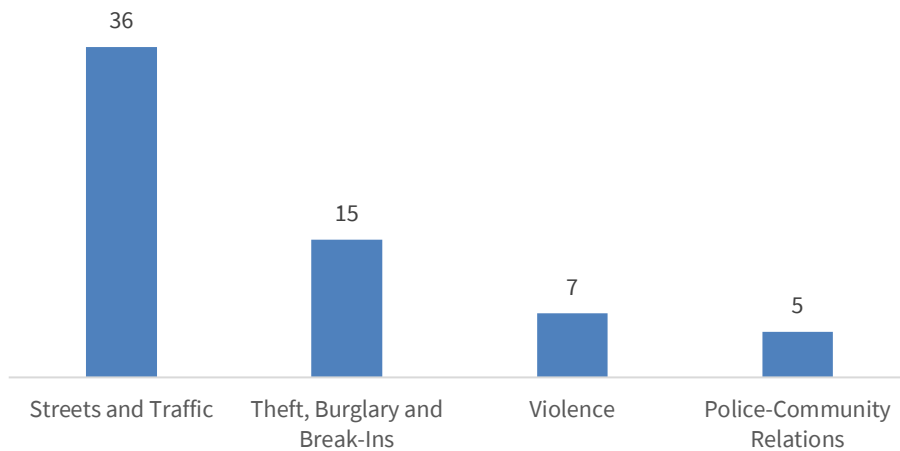
### Top Concerns - District 3



**District 3 leading concerns were distributed as follows:**

- 25% of respondents (24 responses) mentioned Streets and Traffic as their top concern.
- 19% of respondents (18 responses) mentioned Theft, Burglary, and Break-Ins.
- 12.5% of respondents (12 responses) mentioned Violence.
- 7% of respondents (7 responses) mentioned Noise.

### Top Concerns - District 4



**District 4 leading concerns were distributed as follows:**

- 42% of respondents (36 responses) mentioned Streets and Traffic as their top concern.
- 18% of respondents (15 responses) mentioned Theft, Burglary, and Break-Ins.
- 8% of respondents (7 responses) mentioned Violence.
- 6% of respondents (5 responses) mentioned Police-Community Relations.
- Additional 5 responses (60%) mentioned Noise.
