Summary

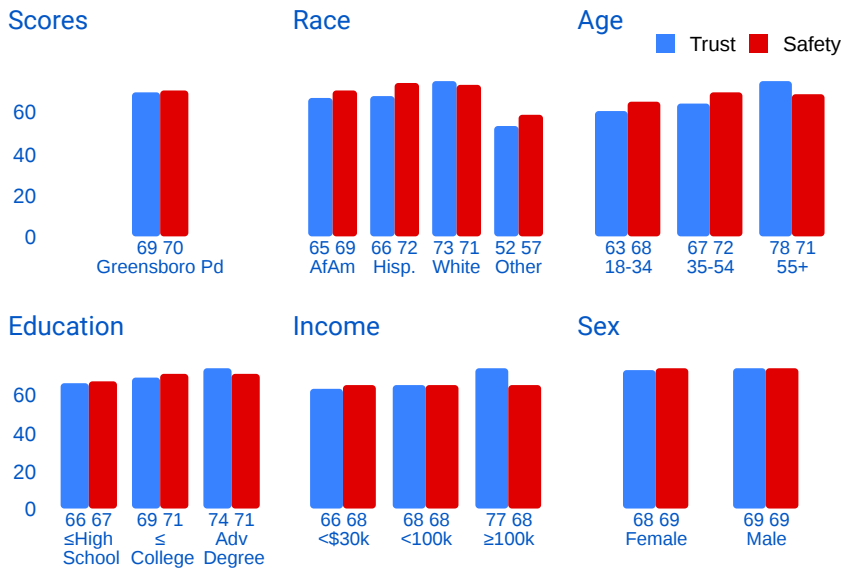
This report is based on 658 survey responses collected from all major demographic groups in Greensboro, NC, between January 1st and March 31st, 2023 (Q1).

CityWide Trust score (69) was steady over the last quarter. In District 3, has seen a declining trend in the last six months (from 70 to 66).

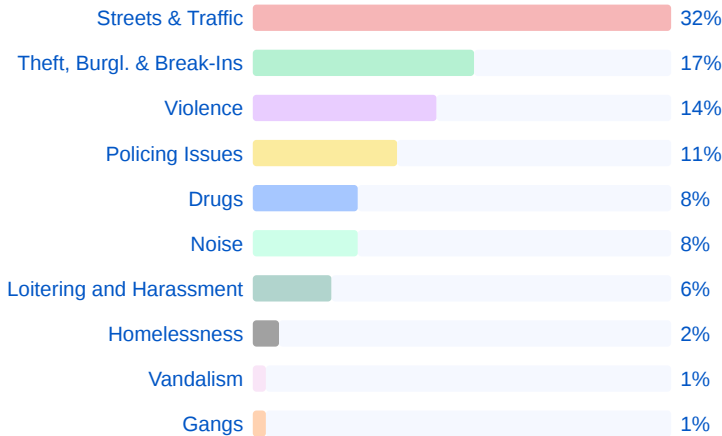
CityWide Safety score went up by one point (70).

Streets & Traffic is still the main topic of concern (32% of comments). Theft, Burglary & Break-Ins is the second topic of concern (17%).

How are concerns measured?

Residents are asked the following question: "What is the number one issue or problem on your block or in your neighborhood that you'd like the Police to deal with?"

We process the hundreds of replies received each quarter and categorize them so you have a sense of what people would like to see from the Greensboro Police Department.
