


FY 2024-2033 MTIP Funding Overview




FY 2024-2033 MTIP Funding Overview





Summary of Comments


- The **greatest need identified** was the construction of bike lanes, followed by improving pedestrian safety by providing sidewalks and making the transportation infrastructure safer.
- The <u>most important projects</u> identified included the A&Y Greenway for sections going north and south into downtown. Roadway and transit projects were also mentioned including the Battleground Avenue and Wendover interchange reconfiguration as well as transit route and stops improvements.







Recommendation: Amend MTIP

CMAQ Funding Recommendation & MTIP Amendment: New GTA Route I Cross Town Service

- MPO directs CMAQ allocations made available by NCDOT
- CMAQ eligibility limited to air quality beneficial projects
- CMAQ is the only federal program eligible to support new service operating grants
- CMAQ funding recommended for new GTA Route connecting GTCC-G, NCA&TSU, downtown, UNCG & Wendover/ Bridford
- This will be GTA's first crosstown route and first route with 15 minute frequencies during the day

Recent and Pending Bid Openings

Downtown Greenway, Phase 4 - Contract 2015-0030 (EB-6037C)

Bids were opened August 15, 2023 - Yates Construction was apparent low bidder Council approval to be requested September 19, 2023, NCDOT has given verbal approval Work should begin in October 2023 with a completion date of December 2024

Murrow Boulevard Bridge Repairs - Contract 2021-011 (EL-5101DR)

Bids were opened June 29, 2023 - Smith Rowe was apparent low bidder Council has approved bid and NCDOT has provided concurrence Work should begin in January 2024 with a completion date of December 2024

Recent and Pending Bid Openings

General Sidewalk Improvements - Contract 2015-104 (U-5532E)

Revised plans and specifications have been approved by the NCDOT

July 31 bid opening was delayed due to less than three bids, rebid August 21

Contract includes sidewalks on Hornaday Rd., Bridford Pkwy, Big Tree Way, and Hewitt St.

Work should begin in October 2023 with a completion date of September 2024

Davie Street Streetscape - Contract 2018-051A

Revised plans and specifications are under final review

Contract should be advertised in October 2023 with a bid opening in November 2023

Work should begin in December 2023 with a completion date of March 2025

Projects limits are from E. McGee St. to north of E. Friendly Ave.

Alamance Church Road Improvements - Contract 2011-0670

Construction is approximately 70% complete for the project

All water and sanitary sewer work is complete

Widening is being installed in areas where utility installations are complete

Paving by late fall, with construction expected to be completed by spring 2024

Eugene & Bellemeade Streetscape - Contract 2020-0180

Utility installations on Bellemeade Street East are complete

All paving on Bellemeade East is complete except final surface

Eugene St. Streetscape to begin September 25



The completion date is approximately December 2024



Strategic Reports

Smoothed Urban Area Boundary

- Every decade, the MPO is required to adopt a smoothed UZA boundary for FHWA functional classification purposes (rural vs. urban).
- This smoothed boundary is meant to simplify the complex geography of UZAs, by smoothening the boundaries and extending them to include roads that have an urban character.
- The MPO is working with FHWA, NCDOT, and neighboring jurisdictions to create the smoothed UZA and will present the final version at the next TCC meeting.

Smoothed Urban Area Boundary





