
Greensboro, NC | February 1st, 2024 Blockwise - Jan Executive Summary Report




The feed provides open-text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. **Streets & Traffic remain the highest concern for residents, with 36% of the labeled comments. 10% of the comments addressed Police Resources** (14% of comments from District 3).

City Sense of Safety score went up 2 points, with 63% of respondents stating they feel completely or mostly safe in their neighborhood. **A notable rise in all aspects was recorded in District 4**. 43% of residents agree or strongly agree with the statement: "Greensboro PD is an open and transparent organization" with another 40% stating they neither agree nor disagree.
