
Blockwise - March Executive Summary Report




The feed provides open-text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. Streets & Traffic rose to 38% of the labeled comments as the highest concern for Residents. 48% of the comments in District 4 referred to Streets & Traffic. Violence | well (Fairnes - 3 points, Respect - 2 points, Voice - 4 points, rose by 5 points this month, with 11% of the labeld open comments.


City Sense of Safety score went up by 2 points, with 60% of respondents stating they feel completely or mostly safe in their neighborhood. Another drop was noted in all other aspects as Transparency - 5 points). In District 2 a rise was noted in all aspects. 81% of respondents are very or fairly willing to contact the police.


