



The Adopt-A-Street program was created to allow local groups an opportunity to receive recognition for caring for their community by cleaning litter from the Greensboro City owned roadways. The program is a two year agreement requiring the groups to clean up their adopted street at least four times a year (once a quarter) and to report on the cleanup activity.

Supplies: Supplies (trash bags and gloves) will be provided to groups that fill out the supply request at least a week in advance. Neon vests and grabbers can be provided on a first come first serve basis. Supplies can be picked up and returned (if needed), to the Parks and Recreation administrative office front desk at 301 S. Greene Street Greensboro NC 27401 in Suite 300 on the 3rd floor.

Trash: Parks and Recreation will dispose of the trash if you choose not to dispose of it yourselves. In order for Parks and Recreation to dispose of your trash, you will need to fill out the respective area of the cleanup report form with a specific location. Bags of trash and other large debris need to be gathered together in one spot if possible, located three or four feet from the road, and not left on the sidewalk where it can impede foot traffic.

Forms: To adopt a street you will need to sign the Agreement and the Contact form. If requesting supplies for your cleanup day you will need to turn in a supply request a week before. On the day of your cleanup you will need to get all participants to sign the Liability Release Form and have your group leader fill out the Cleanup Report. All forms can be returned electronically or physically. Our e-mail is Adopt-A@greensboro-nc.gov and the address is 301 S. Greene Street Suite 300 Greensboro NC 27401. All forms except the Agreement have an online fill-in version to make it easier to return.

Sign: The Adopt-A-Street sign process begins after your group has completed their second quarter cleanup. After that the group leader can reach out and ask for the Sign Request form. The street segment must be at least 1 mile in length to qualify for a sign.

Where to start?: Think of a few street segments or areas using landmarks or zip codes as reference points that you would want to care for. Then email this information and/or any questions you have to Adopt-A@greensboro-nc.gov
