November 13, 2006 November 26, 2007 In one of its last official acts, the outgoing City Council approved ordinances for the City-initiated annexation of 12 areas. Approval of October 13, 2008 the ordinances followed an annexation schedule that began on October 22, 2007 September 4 when the resolutions of intent to annex were presented to City Council. In late October, the City conducted one October 23, 2006 public informational meeting and two drop-in sessions to provide information about the proposed annexations to residents in the October 27, 2008 areas, and Council held a public hearing on the annexations on October 9, 2006 November 5.
