Schedule Your Rental Property Inspection

Rental units must comply with the minimum housing code.

Beginning July 1, 2007, all rental property in the City of Greensboro must be inspected before it can be rented. Rental property will pass inspection if it is in compliance with the city's minimum housing code. Once it passes inspection, a Rental Unit Certificate of Occupancy (RUCO) will be issued. Certificates are good for five years. To schedule an inspection, call the Building Inspections division at 373-2111.
