

## PRUNING PRINCIPLES FOR PRUNING LARGE BRANCHES

- 1. The first cut (A) undercuts the limb to prevent the bark from ripping down the tree.
- 2. The second cut (B) removes the limb.
- 3. The final cut (C) should be just outside the branch collar to remove the resulting stub.
